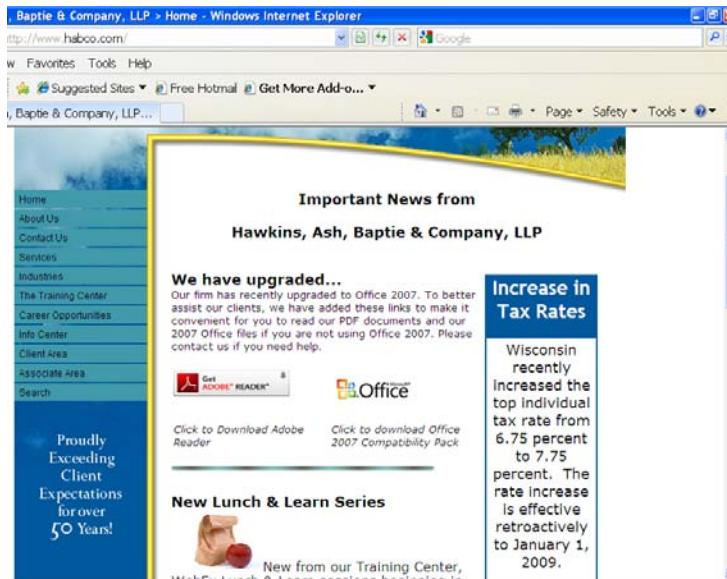


We Have Recently Upgraded our Software Tools...

Our firm has recently upgraded to Office 2007 and Adobe Acrobat 9.0. Office 2007 has introduced new file formats. The new file formats end with a four digit extension rather than the three digit extension in the past. For example, Excel file extensions are now .XLSX and Word files extensions are now .DOCX. As a result, Office 2007 can open and read files created in earlier versions, but earlier versions cannot open and read files created in Office 2007. To better assist our clients who are not using Office 2007, and to eliminate any compatibility or communication issues between us, we have added links on our home page to make it convenient for you to read our PDF and Office 2007 files. Click on the **“Get Adobe Reader”** button to download the latest version of Adobe Reader. This download allows you to read our PDF files. Click on the **“Microsoft Office”** button to download the Office 2007 Compatibility Pack. The Compatibility Pack allows Office XP to read an Office 2007 file for Excel, PowerPoint and Word.
